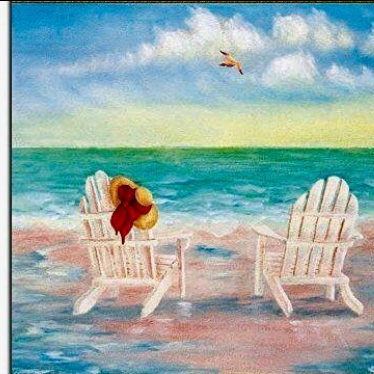

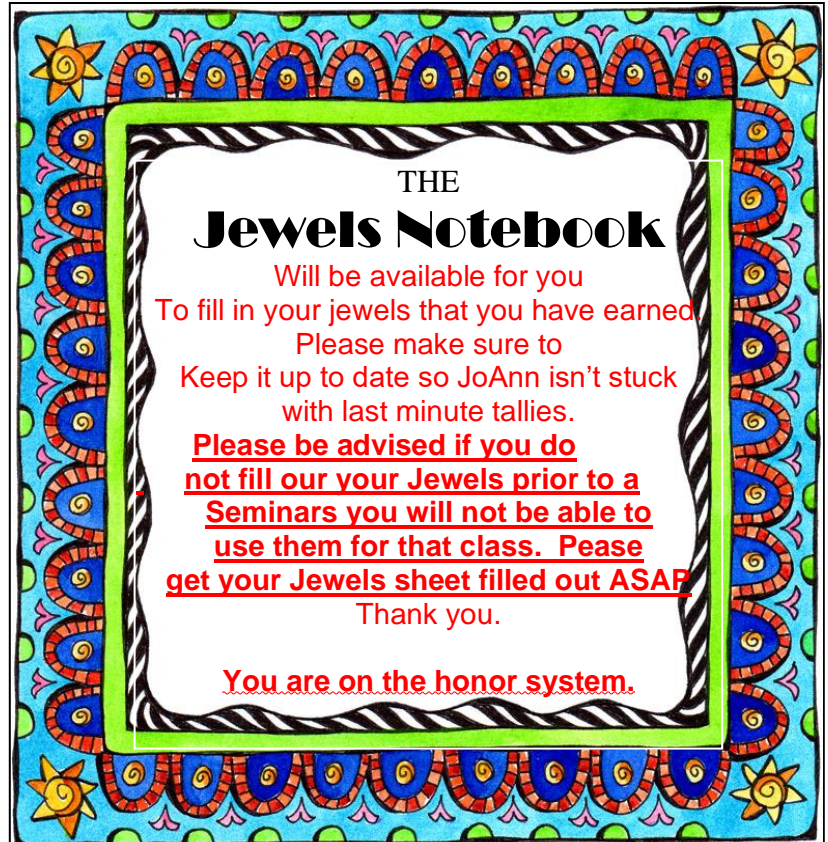

**RECIPE**

This is an old time favorite and I just found it in All Recipes – I remember my mom use to make this for her 6 kids' years ago it went a long way.

Preheat oven to 350 deg.

3 lb skinless, boneless, chicken breast	1 soup can of milk
1 (10.75) can condensed cream of chicken soup	1 ½ cups chicken broth
1(10.75) can condensed cream of celery soup	1 (6oz) package seasoned
cornbread stuffing mix	

Place chicken in a large saucepan full of lightly salted water. Bring to a boil, boil for about 30 min. or until chicken is cooked through (juice run clear). Remove chicken from pan, reserving broth. Cut chicken into bite size pieces and place in bottom of a 9x13 baking pan.

In a medium bowl mix together cream of chicken soup and cream of celery soup. Mix milk with the soups. Pour mixture over chicken. In a small bowl combine stuffing and broth, mix together and spoon mixture over casserole.

Bake in preheated oven for 45 min

Reynolds Foil can be used to keep food moist and cook it evenly and makes clean up easier

Serve over Egg Noodles YUMMMMMMMMM
